Our research shows that three quarters of council services have improved in the last 10 years and people trust their council and councillors to make the right decisions for them and their families. Giving councils the right powers and control over their finances would enable them to do much more. They have the local knowledge and expertise to understand the needs of their areas and they have improved outcomes for residents through their children's services, public health, by building houses and creating green and open spaces.
